SAMPLES ARE TO BE NO MORE THEN 2 OZ.

ONLY TWO SAMPLES MAY BE Poured TO A SINGLE PERSON AT ANY ONE TIME.

ALL PERSONS SERVING ALCOHOL MUST BE 21 YEARS OR OLDER

ALL PERSONS SERVING ALCOHOL ARE REQUIRED TO CHECK WRISTBANDS TO INSURE PATRONS ARE OVER 21. IF CONCERNED, ASK FOR IDENTIFICATION. SERVERS ARE RESPOSIBLE TO VARIFY AGE, NOT SECURITY.

ALL PERSONS SERVING ALCOHOL MUST HAVE COMPLETED A RESPONSIBLE BEVERAGE SERVICE COURSE*.
